Memorandum of Understanding between the All Faculty Association and the

Sonoma County Junior College District

Article 32: Workload December 19, 2018

AFA and the District agree to temporarily modify the following provision of Article 32:

32.04 EXTENDED LECTURE CLASSES: The provisions of section 32.04 will be in effect as a pilot project beginning with the development of the spring 2015 schedule and ending with the development of the spring 2018 schedule. In Fall 2014, only those classes scheduled with a class maximum of seventy (70) or more are eligible for extended lecture. through the Spring semester of 2020.

AFA and the District also note that the MOU regarding Article 32 signed on July 11, 2018 was never integrated into the contract after the contract's expiration on June 30, 2017. This MOU will replace the July 11, 2018 MOU copied below:

32.04 EXTENDED LECTURE CLASSES: The provisions of section 32.04 will be in effect as a pilot project beginning with the development of the spring 2015 schedule and ending with the development of the spring 2018 schedule. In Fall 2014, only those classes scheduled with a class maximum of seventy (70) or more are eligible for extended lecture. for four additional terms/semesters, specifically: Summer 2018, Fall 2018, Spring 2019, and Summer 2019, unless the parties negotiate alternate terms covering this period of time.
