

Memorandum of Understanding
between the
All Faculty Association
and the
Sonoma County Junior College District
regarding
Article 32: Workload
July 11, 2018

WHEREAS, the 2014-2017 Contract between AFA and the District established a pilot program regarding extended lecture classes, which expired upon the development of the spring 2018 schedule. (See Article 32.04); and


WHEREAS, the 2014-2017 Contract expired on June 30, 2017, and AFA and the District have not yet negotiated a successor agreement; and

WHEREAS, in the absence of a successor agreement, expiration of the pilot program results in application of the 2011-2014 contract with respect to large lecture classes; and


WHEREAS, AFA and the District mutually wish to provide faculty with a continuation of the pilot program for an additional period while negotiations continue.

NOW THEREFORE, AFA and the District agree to modify the following provisions of Article 32:

32.04 EXTENDED LECTURE CLASSES: The provisions of section 32.04 will be in effect as a pilot project ~~beginning with the development of the spring 2015 schedule and ending with the development of the spring 2018 schedule. In Fall 2014, only those classes scheduled with a class maximum of seventy (70) or more are eligible for extended lecture.~~ **for four additional terms/semesters, specifically: Summer 2018, Fall 2018, Spring 2019, and Summer 2019, unless the parties negotiate alternate terms covering this period of time.**
