Additionally, Instructors not assigned a summer school class will be given 1 point each year they request summer teaching until they receive a summer assignment. The process then begins again. Absent an emergency, no Instructor will be assigned more than one summer class. Should further classes become available, first preference will be given to those Instructors who requested but did not receive a class. This policy does not apply to summer programs abroad.
